In Boy Scout Advancement, the gold-standard is the National Advancement Course at the Philmont Training Center, and we strongly encourage anyone working in the advancement program to take advantage of the PTC course, if at all possible.

However, time, travel and financial commitments have placed the PTC course out of reach for many advancement volunteers, leaving a significant gap in the training available to persons responsible for developing and maintaining a high quality advancement program, compliant with the National Policies and Procedures for Advancement.

The Clinton Valley Council will provide an opportunity in the Central Region for volunteers to gain the benefits of a National Training Course, at an affordable cost, in a manageable time, and in a local place.

A National Boy Scout Advancement Course: Complete, Comprehensive and Convenient.

The Course will be held on Saturday and Sunday, January 24-25, 2009 at the Colombiere Conference Center in Clarkston, Michigan. The course fee of \$149 will cover all course materials, overnight lodging and 4 meals (Saturday lunch thru Sunday lunch). Conference hours will begin with registration on Saturday morning at 7.30 a.m. and conclude on Sunday afternoon at 4 pm. with a Graduate Recognition.

This weekend course, led by Nationally trained facilitators, will provide the Advancement training necessary for the Boy Scout Advancement Staff Professional, Council, District and Unit level advancement chairpersons, to understand and implement appropriate advancement policies and procedures at each level of the advancement program and process.

Enrollment is limited. Registration will be accepted beginning June 1, 2008 until the course is filled.
